Located in the charming historic village of Neauphle-Le-Château, in a very privileged and peaceful environment, this beautiful apartment is located in a house divided into several lots dating from the 19th century. It offers an area of 100 sqm (82.17 sqm under Carrez law) as well as a large terrace. It has been renovated and decorated in a contemporary way with quality materials and careful finishes, while preserving

its character of yesteryear. On the second and last floor, the entrance leads via a few steps to a bedroom with a semi-closed bathroom, then to a superb living room offering a breathtaking view of nature. With high ceilings, an exposed framework (the original beams come from the Palace of Versailles, for the record), and an open kitchen equipped with a central island. The master suite consists of a bedroom, a dressing room and a walk-in shower room. A few steps from the entrance give you access to a pleasant and beautiful southfacing terrace to admire the view of the valley. A laundry room, a cellar and a parking space in the courtyard complete this property. The warm atmosphere, the parquet floors, the beams and the openings to the outside will seduce you, as will the brightness, tranquility, serenity and amenities. 
