Property Description

Located in a tranquil area of the Vaucluse, just 4-minute walk from the nearest amenities, this house dates back to 1980 and requires renovation.

The property offers approximately 170 sq.m of living space; the entrance features a shaded terrace and a hallway. The kitchen has direct access to the terrace, and there is also a storeroom. The open living space is 74 sq.m and includes a dining room with a fireplace, an office, and a living room with a skylight and direct access to the terrace and garden. There is a bedroom with a dressing room, a bathroom, and a toilet on the

ground floor.

Upstairs, there is a landing with a cupboard, one bedroom, and useful space in the attic including a bedroom with a shower room and a toilet. The enclosed, wooded land measures 2670 sq.m and includes a swimming pool with beaches, a bar area, a covered terrace, a changing room area, and a toilet. Additionally, there are outbuildings such as a garage, laundry room, workshop, and another garage. The land is buildable, and there is a possibility of extending and developing garages.

The property has access to town water, mains drainage, and heat pump air conditioning. There is the option to connect to canal water, and the pool is equipped with a solar roller shutter for protection. Renovation work needs to be planned.
