Do you know Villeneuve Loubet?

Villeneuve Loubet is the most missed village on the Cote d'Azur. People arriving in Nice go straight away to Antibes or Cannes, passing this medieval town with so much to offer.

What is there to do in Villeneuve Loubet? The Escoffier Culinary Art Museum is the only French museum dedicated to French gastronomy and culinary art. Built-in the birthplace of Auguste Escoffier, it displays its treasures of more than 300 m²: utensils, menus, testimonials and temporary exhibitions.

The Museum of History and Art of the Old Village offers a unique collection dedicated to the history of the French army in the 20th century, thanks to many interesting objects.

La Maioun dei Granouie is the city's local history museum that authentically and tenderly tells the ways of life of yesteryear.

You can also enjoy walking or cycling to Marina Baie des Anges: a pleasant boulevard designed for pedestrians and cyclists along the marina. Here you are surrounded by four buildings that are shaped like ships.

The Provencal village offers an atmospheric walk through the alleys of the authentic city centre. Pass beautiful old doors in narrow streets steeped in history. The church is located on a beautiful and quiet square where you can admire an overview of the city.

The most missed village on the French Riviera

The boulevard by the sea is only known to the locals who celebrate their daily party on the beach. There are several restaurants and water sports activities to book. From this beach, you can view the Bay of Nice and the

Cap d'Antibes. Villeneuve-Loubet benefits from 5 km of coastline, of which 4 are beaches. The sandy beach of Loup Beach is accessible to people with reduced mobility.

In Park Vaugrenier, you can run, cycle or walk your dog for hours on numerous paths, large landscaped meadows, playgrounds for children and a sports course. This forest is perfect for going alone or with the family. Two observatories offer to study an exceptional natural biotope protecting a natural freshwater pond.

The Rives du Loup park is an urban park that touches three municipalities, including Villeneuve-Loubet. Here you can discover access paths and picnic areas along the river du Loup.

Villeneuve Loubet offers a great equestrian centre and the Canyon Forest adventure area. To access the activities such as tree climbing or outdoor laser gaming, you have to take a 2.5 km walk from the reception to the park, along the river Le Loup. Access is only possible on foot (30 minutes) or by bike (10 minutes). Villeneuve Loubet is full of adventure!
